

California Proposition 65 Compliance

What is California Proposition 65?

California Proposition 65 (CP65), also called the Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act, was enacted in 1986. It is intended to help Californians make informed decisions about protecting themselves from chemicals known to cause cancer, birth defects or other reproductive harm. A new amendment to the law (passed in 2016 and effective August 30, 2018) requires reasonable warnings defined by the California Code of Regulators. This new amendment requires a warning label if two conditions are met: (1) the product contains one or more substances of a list of over 900 chemicals and (2) there is a human exposure of concern above "safe harbor" levels (where applicable) resulting in potential reproductive or carcinogenic impact.

What is PSG- GR / Blackmer doing to be compliant?

At PSG-GR we are committed to being active stewards of the environment. We provide products that are fully compliant with applicable regulations and standards. Our products are designed based on industry accepted codes and standards for product safety, integrity, quality and performance specifications. The materials used in the manufacturing of our products are selected to provide our customers with the highest quality products while minimizing environmental and health concerns. Based upon our current knowledge of our products, we do not believe that any of our products meets *either* of the Prop 65 criteria; (1) the product contains one of more of the 900 chemicals *and* (2) there is an exposure level above OEHHA defined "safe harbor" limits. However, PSG-GR / Blackmer cannot feasibly test every product that we ship and has not tested all products for every one of the approximately 900 chemicals on the Prop 65 list. Therefore, we have made it our policy to include a warning label on every product that we ship.

Where would the warning symbol appear?

The warning can appear on the product, packaging, within the manuals and other documentation and online websites.
